Philosophy

At Blessed Trinity Catholic School we feel that all children have the right to the care essential for their best social, emotional and intellectual development. Our goal is to nurture each child's individual talents, independence, and faith in a safe environment. Cub Club provides support to the children with help from the families, the school and the parish communities. Children are encouraged to share their joys, and talk out their difficulties. Each child is regarded as capable, responsible and a special person.

Our program focuses on healthy development and we strive to provide a homelike atmosphere for our preschool students at Blessed Trinity before and after their class time. Children are encouraged to participate in a variety of activities. Children may paint and draw pictures, make craft projects, play games, build with blocks, read, enjoy time outside.

Cub Club children will have classes with specialists in physical education, music, and art. They will have access to the Penn campus library, computer lab, and indoor and outdoor play areas. They will have the option of ordering hot lunch, and will have a nap/rest time each day. We promote respect for individual differences by maintaining a caring Christian environment.

Registration

Parents registering their child must be enrolled in our preschool program and complete and submit the Blessed Trinity Cub Club registration form.

A completed Emergency and Health Information Sheet must be updated and in the Cub Club files for all students.

Payments are due by the 10th day of the month on a consistent monthly basis.

Enrollment Policy

Blessed Trinity Cub Club has been designed to serve the needs of children in our 3 year old and 4 year old preschool classes. Full-time contracted enrollment is for families who register for all five days Monday through Friday care before and/or after class time. This contracted enrollment is open on a space available basis.

Blessed Trinity Cub Club does not discriminate in enrollment or disenrollment on the basis of race, sex, religion, creed, color, national origin or source of payment.

Part-time & Drop-in Enrollment

Part-time enrollment is a minimum of two days per week and up to 4 days per week. Drop-in enrollment is available on a very limited basis.

These students will be accommodated as space permits with the following criteria:

- The child/staff ratio must maintain a staff to child ratio of 1:10
- The size and availability of school facilities
- The desire to meet ratio and facility size standards set by the State of Minnesota

Those parents who desire a place for their child(ren) in Cub Club and cannot be accommodated, will be placed on a waiting list.

Hours

Blessed Trinity Cub Club is open from 7:00 AM to 5:30 PM. Cub Club students may attend Club Tiger if they arrive between 6:30 AM and 7:00 AM or leave after 5:30 PM. All students must be picked up promptly at 6:00 PM. The program is in session every school day and a current non-school day schedule will be updated yearly.

Summer 2012

Blessed Trinity Cub Club will accept children registered in Blessed Trinity's preschool 3 year old program (if they are toilet trained) for care this summer. Four year old preschoolers and 2009-10 Kindergarteners will also be accepted for summer care.

Those registering for summer care must purchase an Edina Pool pass, as the children will go to the pool with Club Tiger twice per week. Children in Cub Club will join Club Tiger for some summer field trips to be announced. These will require additional fees. All children attend all field trips.
